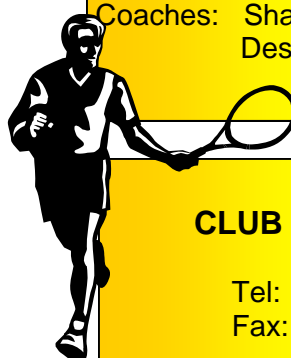

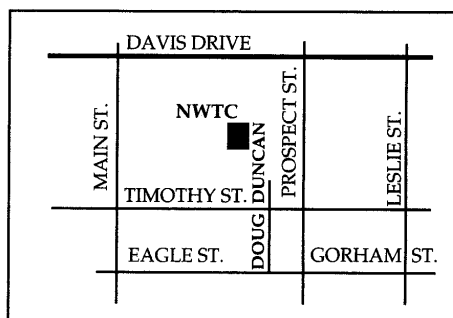

ADULT CLUB ACTIVITIES

ROUND ROBINS

For the past several years the focal point of our adult programme has been our popular round robins. A round robin is a two hour activity organized by the club whereby players of similar ability play with and against several different partners in friendly doubles matches. The club supplies the balls. Fees are \$11 daytime and \$14 weekends and evenings. Seniors fees on Monday and Thursday are \$10. Following is a list of all adult round robins.

Note: Please arrive 10 minutes early for round robins and be ready to play at the scheduled time.

LADIES HOUSE LEAGUE

Ladies doubles matches are played on Tuesday morning from 9-11 am; 11 am-1.00 pm; and from 1 -3.00 pm. Players are organized into three levels, to ensure fairly even play. A practice and assessment day is scheduled for Tuesday, October 4th at 9am. The fee each week is \$12. New balls will be provided for each group. (A new evening House league will be offered at Crossland: 7-8.30 pm and 8.30-10 p.m. for \$10.)

MEN'S HOUSE LEAGUES

On Wednesday and Thursday nights the club's top male players play competitive doubles in organized leagues. Tryouts will be held Wednesday, October 5th. from 9-11 pm. Cost is \$14 weekly. New balls are provided.

THURSDAY INDISCRIMINATE LEAGUE

This league comprises teams from Newmarket, Aurora, Richmond Hill and Woodbridge and is geared for those ladies who play at the B and C level. Matches are played from 9-11 am and refreshments are provided by the home teams. Tryouts for B1 and B2 teams will be held Thursday, October 6th. from 9-11 am. Cost is \$11 per play.

FRIDAY YORK NORTH LEAGUE

This league includes teams from the same locales as the Thursday Indiscriminate League but is geared to the A and Majors levels. Matches are played home and away from 9-11 am, followed by refreshments. Tryouts will be held on Friday,

October 7th. from 9-11 am.

MEN'S INTER-CLUB

On Sunday evenings our Men's "A" Team will be competing against teams from all over Metropolitan Toronto and York Region. The team is made up of 3 doubles tandems that play at an Inter-County "A" and Majors level. If you are interested in playing for this team, tryouts will be held Sunday, October 9th. at 7 pm.

SATURDAY NIGHT PARTIES

A) PRO'S MEMBER/GUEST PARTIES

A Saturday night tennis party, with one of the pro's playing in. Enjoy good tennis, music and nibbles and a great social evening with your friends! Register at the desk when the sign-up sheets are posted as space is limited for these popular events.

B) PRIVATE PARTIES

Many community clubs, social organizations, and private groups have booked the entire club on Saturday nights to host their own tennis parties. It's a great way to entertain friends; get a group together and organize a pot luck supper. The fee of \$296 includes all three courts from 7 - 11 pm as well as a staff member on hand to assist you and provide your group with complimentary coffee.

BOOKINGS

You may book a court a full week in advance, either in person, by phone or via our online system at www.newmarket-wintertennis.ca. The club reserves the right to limit singles bookings to one hour.

GUEST FEES

Guest fees are \$10 per adult and \$5 per junior/senior. A member may bring as many guests as they wish, however, the same guest may only use the facilities once per month to a maximum of 4 times per season. FAILURE to register your guest could result in forfeiting your membership.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In fairness to all members, you must give the club 48 hours notice when cancelling courts, round robins, or house leagues, etc., otherwise you will be billed for the whole amount.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRO

Welcome to another winter season at N.W.T.C. As your club pro, I have a bevy of options for you to help you improve your tennis game. We offer one hour group lessons for all levels of play - these are an excellent way, to learn and practice tennis, skills. My weekly clinics are 90 minutes long and are an ideal way to hone your skills in an enjoyable drill environment. During the clinics, the pace is a little faster and I focus more on playing points and practicing strokes in competitive situations. In addition to these weekly lessons and clinics, more individual instruction can be arranged. I look forward to helping you achieve your tennis goals this winter!

INSTRUCTION

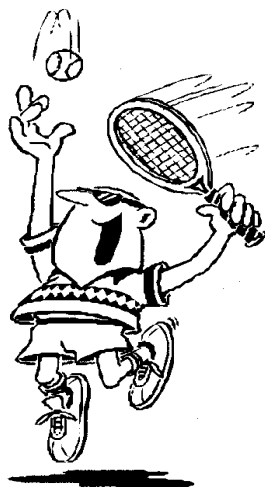
